Outcomes of the SET-Plan Conference

- > Thematic sessions on energy sectors covered by the SET-Plan.
- The EC used the sessions to gather additional recommendations for the revision of the SET-Plan.
- ➤ The revised SET-Plan will be announced early 2023.
- > On ETIPWind's side, we put forward the following recommendations:
- 1. Aligning the objectives of the SET-Plan with the EU climate and energy targets
- 2. Ensuring ETIPs provide more targeted policy and funding recommendations and collaborate more strategically
- 3. Prioritising the different Implementation Working Groups (IWGs)
- 4. Increasing the impact of ETIPs

How to structure the work

Initial proposal:

3 Working Groups:

- Permanent groups dedicated to 3 major R&I themes
- Leading the discussion on key technical topics
- > Participants: SC members
- Chaired by WG leaders
- Possible structure:

WG1: Supply chain issues and manufacturing

WG2: Next Generation Technologies and circularity

WG3: Electrification, Grid & System integration

1 Task Force:

- > To discuss a transversal topic
- Only one TF at a time
- On a cross-cutting issues (e.g. skills and human resources)
- > For a specific period (e.g. 6 months)
- Participants: SC members + sponsored experts
- Chair by a TF leader.



Next steps and closing remarks

- Timelines and additional ideas will be combined. A final document describing the **full work programme** will be shared and finalised before Christmas.
- ➢ Input for the consultation on the Horizon Europe strategic planning 2025-2027 (general recommendations on R&I priorities)
- ➤ **Next meeting**: Catch-up call before Xmas + Working session on HEU strategic planning beginning of January
- > New repository on Teams: soon available.
