





## The impact of ETIPWind in 2020

✓ Workshop -> R&I to deliver 450 GW of offshore wind








#### **Work Programme 2021 – Changes**










# Global public funding for wind energy research & innovation (in € million, 2019 prices)




# Cumulative EU funding for research in renewables (in € million, 2019 constant prices)


# Wind energy funding in H2020 work programme '18-'20 on Energy (in € million)




